

It's Potty Time!

This is a friendly reminder that school is right around the corner, and your child needs to be fully potty trained to join their classmates in the Owl class. This means your child is able to tell the teachers when they need to use the potty, can spend the day in underwear, and are regularly accident free. There are only a few weeks till school starts, so keep working on it! Here are some tips that will help your child have an easier time using the potty at school:

- Begin using the adult potty at home instead of a potty chair. Use a stool if necessary! The big potties can be scary if they are still using a training chair at home and they'll be more comfortable if you are the one helping them get used to it.
- Help your child use the potty without removing all their clothing. Leaving their shoes on with pants and underwear around their ankles would be very helpful!
- Help your child learn to wipe their bottoms. Always have your child wipe first before you check and make sure they are clean.
- Encourage your child to pull up their own underwear and pants when they are finished using the potty.
- Let your child use the potty in public. He will become more comfortable with a potty that isn't at home.
